California Privacy Notice (Your California Privacy Rights)

1. Categories of Personal Information Collected

We may collect (and may have collected within the past 12 months) the following categories of personal information about California residents in the context of our business-to-business interactions:

4. Disclosure of Personal Information

We may disclose personal information to the following categories of third parties:

- Our affiliates and subsidiaries
- Service providers who support our business operations
- Legal or regulatory authorities where required by law

We **do not sell** or **share** your personal information **in exchange for money**. However, we may use tracking technologies considered "sharing" under CPRA for targeted advertising purposes. This includes **sharing personal information with third parties for cross-context behavioural advertising**, such as through the use of analytics and advertising tools (e.g., LinkedIn, Matomo).

California residents have the right to opt out of the sale or sharing of their personal information. To exercise this right, you may submit a request by completing the form indicated in Section 6 below.

We honour opt-out preferences through mechanisms such as the **Global Privacy Control** (**GPC**) signal, where applicable.

- Right to Limit Use of Sensitive Personal Information: Not applicable as we do not collect such data in B2B interactions.
- **Right to Non-Discrimination**: You have the right not to receive discriminatory treatment for exercising your privacy rights.
